Mr. McGregor's Potting Bench **Open to all**

Using a terra-cotta pot at least 6 inches in size with incorporated florals as well as herbs must include at least two of the following: rosemary, thyme, lavender, basil, or any other herb of choice. Any mini garden tools can be incorporated or standard garden tools (trowels, rakes, hoes, gloves, etc.). Extra added bonuses: moss, bark, twigs, or any natural elements from the outside.

Most Beautiful Garden **Open to all**

Using soft, romantic florals of your choice from cut garden ranunculus, daisies, garden roses, dahlias, zinnias, etc.. Make it a natural design in a gardening container that is to be a table size arrangement. Make sure the arrangement has a nice focal point and a good color basis. You may add other components of choice.

Kids Only! **Open to youth 14 and under**

Using a child size wheelbarrow, garden tools, pot, mini fences, watering cans, crates, baskets, pails, or any choice out of Mr McGregor's book, let the little gardener create with vegetables and flowers. The design should be at least table top size, incorporate flowers from a homegrown garden, and any outdoor product that adds to it for fun. Bonus: add a character from the book into the design.

Garden Galore **Open to all**

Use at least two of the following in your floral design: cabbage, kale, carrots, cucumber, combo, orange, green, red, or yellow pepper, turnip, or any fruits, herbs (rosemary, basil, thyme, lavender, sage, cilantro, parsley, or any of choice), and incorporate garden flowers. Astors or what may be blooming in your garden container can be of one's choice. Create a focal point and color palette that goes with your design. Bonus: Be creative and use a vegetable as a container!
